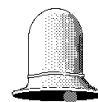
Holy Cross-Immaculata Parishioners are invited to pray the rosary as a group before all the weekend Masses during the month of October.

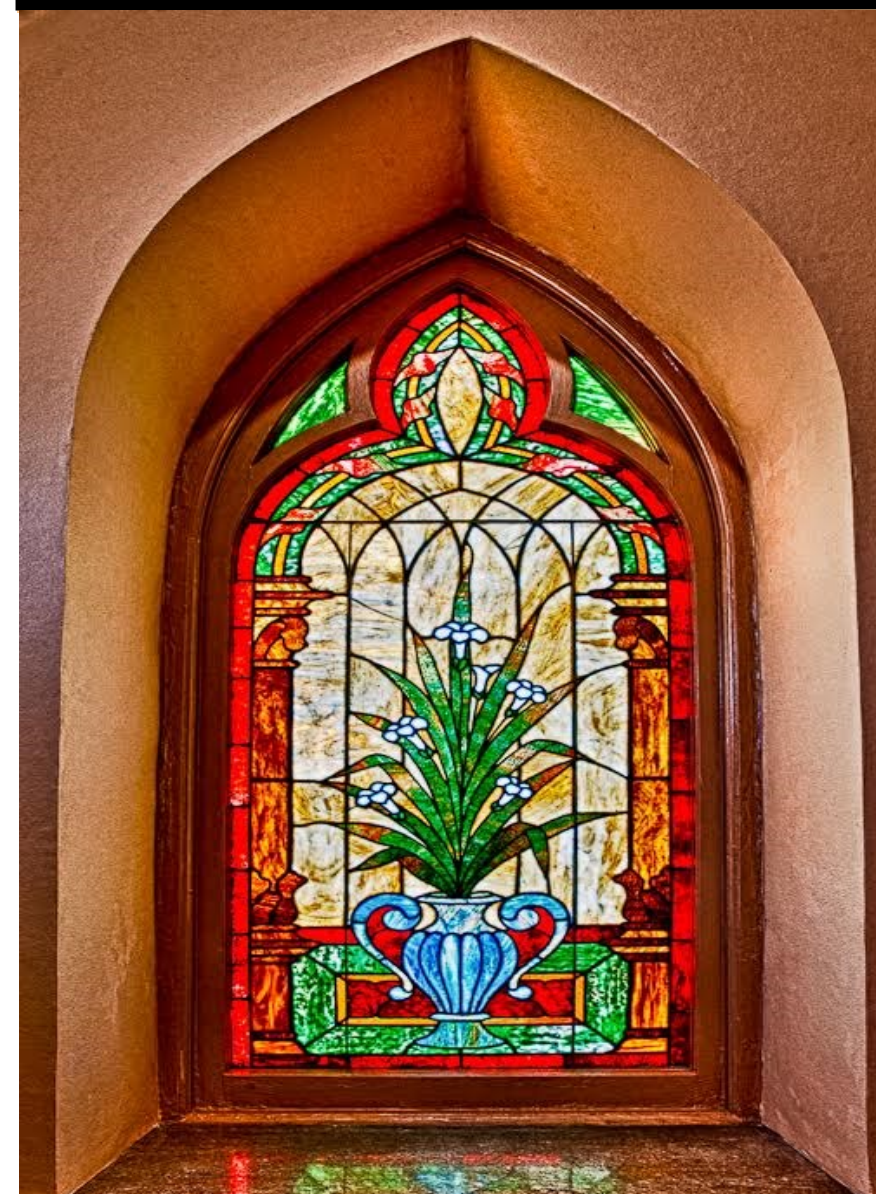
