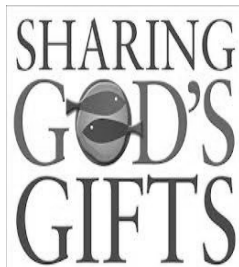

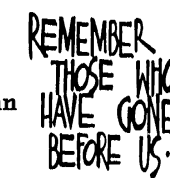

Older buildings require regular maintenance, and there is always a possibility of unforeseen repairs and expenditures.

Establishing a larger reserve fund will also provide us with the seed money to consider new projects to upgrade our buildings or to expand the scope of our parish ministries.
